**MOTION OF BUCKEYE TELESYSTEM, INC.  
FOR REVIEW OF A DECISION OF  
THE NORTH AMERICAN NUMBERING POOLING ADMINISTRATOR**

Buckeye TeleSystem, Inc. ("Buckeye") is a certificated local exchange carrier providing service to primarily business customers in northwest Ohio. Buckeye has a new customer, Sandusky City Schools ("the Schools") located at 407 Decatur Street, Sandusky, Ohio 44870-2442 that Buckeye plans to serve in the near future.

The Schools have requested that Buckeye provide it with local dial tone service for its two ISDN PRIs and its analog business lines. The Schools also request to have a consecutive block of 1,000 DID numbers from the Sandusky rate center in order to renumber its district phone system. The Schools are requesting this clean block of 1,000 DID numbers so that the public will be able to understand which facility they are calling.

Having a clean block of 1,000 DID numbers from the Sandusky rate center will also help the School's employees in recognizing if a call is being placed to a physical phone or a voice mail box helping to set expectations of a reply. In addition, having the consecutive block of 1,000 DID numbers will provide the Schools with a much easier call routing patterns within its switch to route calls. This will save the Schools labor costs for system support.

The Schools request that in this clean block of numbers, the last four numbers not begin with a 7 or a 0. This is because the digit 7 is the Schools outside line indicator and the number 0 has caused some routing issues for the Schools. Buckeye has determined that in area code 419,

the prefix “984” has available the 1,000, 2,000, 3,000, 4,000, 5,000, 6,000 and 8,000 NXX series of numbers.

Buckeye prepared its Months To Exhaust and Utilization Certification Work Sheet – TN level and found that it does not meet the month’s to exhaust to deplete current inventory (MTE) within six months of obtaining a new code block. See Attachment A. In addition, Buckeye found that the utilization for the Sandusky rate center was only 59.434% instead of the FCC requirement of 75%.

Attachment B consists of the Thousands-Block Application Form – Part 1A for tracking number 419-Sandusky-OH-525646 which was prepared by Buckeye.

Buckeye has submitted a request to the Pooling Administrator which was denied on March 23, 2012. The explanation for the denial given was as follows:

DR-57: You do not meet the MTE and/or utilization requirements, therefore this request for a new block is denied. You may proceed with requesting a State Waiver from the appropriate state commission using this Part 3 denial. If you are in disagreement with the disposition of this request, please refer to the Thousands Block Number (NXX-X) Pooling Administration Guidelines for the appeals process.

Attachment D is a letter from Brett Kluiber, Technology Coordinator for the Sandusky City Schools to Robert Martin of Buckeye.

Attachment E is a downloaded report from the PAS displaying various code blocks in the Sandusky rate center. Buckeye is filing this motion before the Commission requesting a waiver for the sole purpose of obtaining a clean block of 1,000 numbers for the Schools from the Sandusky rate center. The FCC’s Rules set forth a procedure whereby denial of a numbering resource by the pooling administration system can be brought to the appropriate state commission for review.


It is reasonable for the Schools to renumber its district phone system so that the public will have the ability to understand which facility they are calling. In addition, it is reasonable to obtain a consecutive block of 1,000 DID numbers so that the School employees will know if a call is being placed to a physical phone or a voice mail box and that the call routing patterns within the School's switch will allow it to route calls saving the district labor costs for system support.

The Commission has authority to review the PAS decision and issue a waiver to PAS authorizing assignment of the NPA-NXXs requested by Buckeye.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Buckeye respectfully requests that the Commission or its Attorney Examiner act expeditiously and issue an Order providing a waiver to the PAS and authorizing assignment of the numbering resources that Buckeye has requested on behalf of the Sandusky City Schools.
