ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) By entry dated February 9, 2012, the hearing in this complaint case was continued for the second time, until April 19, 2012.
- (2) On April 10, 2012, Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison) filed a third motion to continue the hearing and a request for an expedited ruling. In the motion, Ohio Edison requested that the April 19, 2012, hearing be continued for 45 days.
- (3) In support of its motion, Ohio Edison stated that the parties have been engaged in settlement discussions, which include several terms requiring engineering cost estimates and plans, and that the current hearing date will not allow the parties adequate time to obtain this information and attempt to finalize a settlement agreement. Further, Dr. Paquelet has agreed to this continuance to allow the parties to advance their efforts to settle this matter.
- (4) In view of the continued settlement discussions between the parties, Ohio Edison's request for a continuance is reasonable and should be granted.
- (5) Accordingly, the hearing should be continued to 10:00 a.m. on June 14, 2012, in hearing room 11-C, on the 11th floor of the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED That Ohio Edison's motion for a continuance of the hearing in this case be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the hearing in this case be rescheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. on June 14, 2012, in hearing room 11-C, on the 11th floor of the offices of the Commission. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


