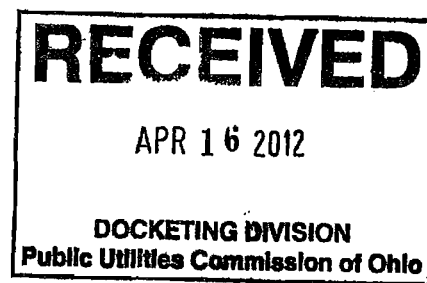

In response to the proposed sewer increase to the Briarwood Development in Richfield Village Ohio by Water & Sewer, LLC of Woodmere, please find the enclosed document as comparison of sewer rates in Summit County and other municipalities within the state of Ohio. You will find that in 2009 Water & Sewer, LLC asked for an increase of 121.2 percent and received by the PUCO 75.65 percent over current rates at that time.

Water and Sewer Rate Case

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) is the state agency charged with assuring all residential and business consumers access to adequate, safe and reliable utility services. The PUCO regulates providers of electric and natural gas service, local and long distance telephone companies, water and waste water companies and rail and trucking companies. The five PUCO commissioners must balance the interests of consumers, the utility and other interest groups.

Quick facts about the Water and Sewer Rate Case

- Water and Sewer filed an application to increase rates on September 23, 2011. Water and Sewer requested an increase in sewer revenue of \$41,260.00, or a 40.11 percent increase over current revenues.
- The PUCO staff conducted an investigation from October 2011 to January 2012. On February 22, 2012 the PUCO staff filed a report that recommended a revenue increase in the range of \$32,198 to \$33,359 or a 31.30 percent to 32.60 percent increase over current revenues.

**PUCO schedules public hearing for Water & Sewer, LLC rate case**

COLUMBUS, OHIO (Feb. 29, 2012) – The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) has scheduled a public hearing to give customers of Water & Sewer, LLC the opportunity to express their opinion on the company's application to increase rates for wastewater services.

The hearing will be held on Wednesday, April 11, at 6 p.m. at the city of Richfield Administration Building located at 4410 Streetsboro Road, in Richfield.

On Sept. 23, 2011, Water & Sewer filed an application with the PUCO to increase its rates for wastewater service by \$41,260, or approximately 40 percent, over current annual revenues. The company serves approximately 75 sewer customers in Richfield Township.

Briarwood residents protest sewer rate hike at public hearing

RICHFIELD — Residents of Richfield's Briarwood subdivision packed the Richfield Village Council chambers at an April 13 Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) hearing to protest their sewer provider's request for a 121.2 percent rate increase.

Water & Sewer LLC, of Woodmere, which currently provides water and sewer service for 36 single-family homes and 36 condominiums in the subdivision, located in the village and Richfield Township, has requested a 121.2 percent increase for its wastewater services. A PUCO staff report has recommended commissioners grant an increase of between 75.65 percent and 77.26 percent over current rates.

Water & Sewer LLC, owned by real estate developer Randy Kertesz, previously agreed to turn over its water lines to Richfield Village, which has an agreement with the city of Cleveland for water service, so it no longer is seeking an increase in water rates. The transfer, which one resident said had been promised by March, has not been completed.

Resident Dean Uher, of Burrwood Drive, said he believed the transfer still was 90 to 120 days away and asked that PUCO commissioners wait until the transfer is complete before granting any rate increase for sewer.

Resident Colleen McDevitt, of Scanwood Drive, said four families from her neighborhood have lost their homes to foreclosure in the last year and attributed part of their problem to the high water and sewer rates charged by Water & Sewer LLC. Residents have said in past meetings on the issue that their water rates are more than \$250 a month. She asked PUCO Hearing Examiner Jeff Jones to not recommend the increase to the PUCO commissioners.

Resident Victoria Cowell, of Sawbridge Drive, testified that she had been laid off from her job after a three-month disability leave and broke down into tears as she told Jones the higher sewer bills may push her into foreclosure as well.

Summit County Council President Nick Kostandaras (D-District 1), who is the district representative and also a Richfield Village resident, testified that proposed annual sewer bills of \$1,650 per customer were "totally unreasonable."

Residents maintain they are being penalized for poor business decisions made by the sewer company's owner. The plant was built with capacity to serve 300-plus homes, said McDevitt, and that oversized facility means greater overhead costs that are being passed on to customers, residents said.

Kertesz, through Richfield Furnace Run LLC, has been denied permission to build high-density housing on the adjacent 116 acres he owns in Richfield Township.

Resident Belinda Stucky, of Scanwood Drive, testified that she believed Kertesz was "holding us hostage" in his effort to persuade township officials to grant the zoning variance he needs for the proposed development. Stucky's assertion was echoed by other residents.

Richfield Village Mayor Michael Lyons said the long-running dispute over the undeveloped parcel was an issue a year ago when the village, the township and Summit County were working on an agreement with Kertesz to turn over water lines to the village. Over the years, Richfield Furnace Run has proposed several high-density projects, which don't comply with the township or village zoning regulations, according to Lyons.

"One year ago, when we were working to resolve the water issue, the owner kept trying to insert zoning into the resolution of the water issue," Lyons said.

In addition to protesting the increased rates, residents testified they did not think the proposed flat billing was fair to all customers. The PUCO staff recommendation sent to commissioners for consideration proposes that each residential customer share equally in the amount Water & Sewer LLC is allowed to charge. That means a household with a family of four would pay the same amount as the household of a single person, residents said.

Barth Royer, attorney for Water & Sewer LLC, said the staff recommendation was made to protect customers. The PUCO staff expected customers' water usage to increase after the switch to city of Cleveland water. Increased use of water combined with new per-cubic-foot-sewer rates could artificially inflate customers' bills, Royer said.

The PUCO had a second public hearing scheduled for April 15 in Columbus. Following that hearing, Jones said some briefs may be filed and he would make his recommendation to the PUCO commissioners. The commissioners may act on the rate increase request 30 to 60 days after receiving all recommendations.

When asked by an audience member if PUCO ever denied a rate increase, Jones, seeming uncomfortable, said the commission almost always grants rate increase requests, but not always by the percentage requested.

PUCO regulates investor-owned water and sewer companies throughout the state. According to PUCO literature, utilities, under Ohio law, are entitled to recover from their customers expenses associated with operating a public utility and earn a reasonable rate of return on their infrastructure investments.

In investigating Water & Sewer LLC's request for a sewer rate increase, PUCO staff members conducted site visits, interviewed company employees and government officials, reviewed company records and performed analysis of data, including financial information from Water & Sewer LLC, PUCO documents stated. The staff recommendations were developed from this information. PUCO commissioners are not bound by the recommendations and can adopt some and reject others.

Going off the hearing record to answer a question from the audience, Jones said he had heard testimony in rate-hike cases for other small water and sewer utilities and the increases requested by Water & Sewer LLC are similar to rate hikes requested in those cases. He said the increase requested by Water & Sewer LLC was similar to a recent request from Mohawk Utilities, which provides water for about 1,000 customers in Carroll County.

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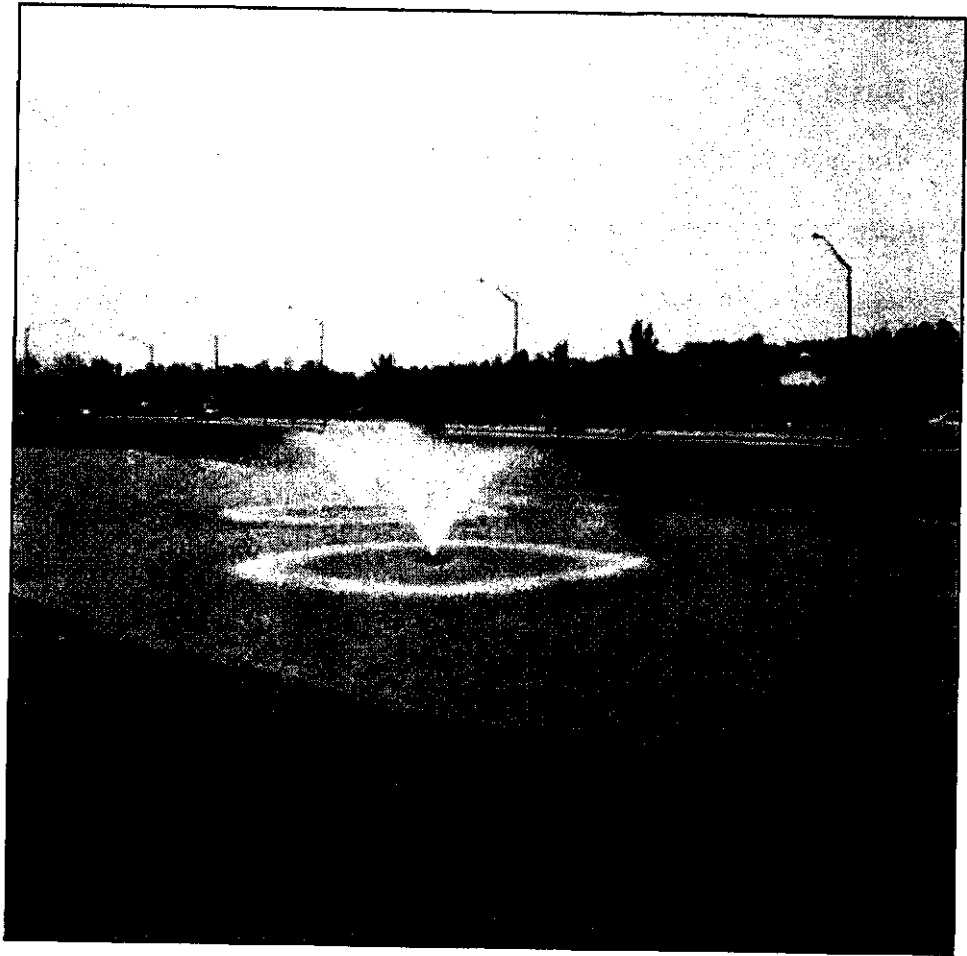

2009 Sewer and Water Rate Survey

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Introduction

The Sewer and Water Rate Survey's central purpose is to collect and publish Ohio residential sewer and water rates. Year 2009 rates were collected from the twenty-sixth annual Sewer and Water Rate Survey, conducted by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. Ohio EPA sent survey questionnaires to 635 municipalities and districts and received 545 responses (86%).

The 2009 Sewer and Water Rate Survey also gathered information regarding the following:

- Sewer Tap-in Fees
- Water Tap-in Fees

Historic survey data and sewer and water rates for over 500 cities, villages and districts during the 1984-2009 periods are available on online at Ohio EPA's Office of Fiscal Administration web page located at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/ofa/>.

Sewer and Water Rate Calculations

Sewer and water charges usually depend on consumption measured in gallons or cubic feet, and are billed monthly, bimonthly or quarterly. In order to standardize sewer and water rates across Ohio and to allow for comparisons among systems, the 2009 Sewer and Water Rate Survey presents rates calculated for an assumed level of consumption.

Annual rates were calculated for residential customers within municipal limits, assuming that a household consists of three (3) people individually consuming 85 gallons of water each day. Community annual sewer and water rate calculations assumed one of the following as the average water consumption per household:

- 7,756 gallons per month (1,037 cubic feet per month)
- 15,512 gallons bi-monthly (2,074 cubic feet bi-monthly)
- 23,268 gallons per quarter (3,111 cubic feet per quarter)

The rates in Appendices 2 and 3 include charges levied for direct use of sewer and water systems. Charges unrelated to sewer and water use, such as income and property taxes, have not been included in rate calculations. Information about other revenue sources has been noted in the appendices, when available.

Privately owned sewer and water systems may be funded differently than some public systems. As a result, the sewer and water rates charged by privately owned companies may be higher than some public systems.

Actual sewer and water charges for individual households will be higher (or lower) than those listed in Appendices 2 and 3 for those households with average, metered water use more (or less) than 7,756 gallons per month.

Sewer Rates

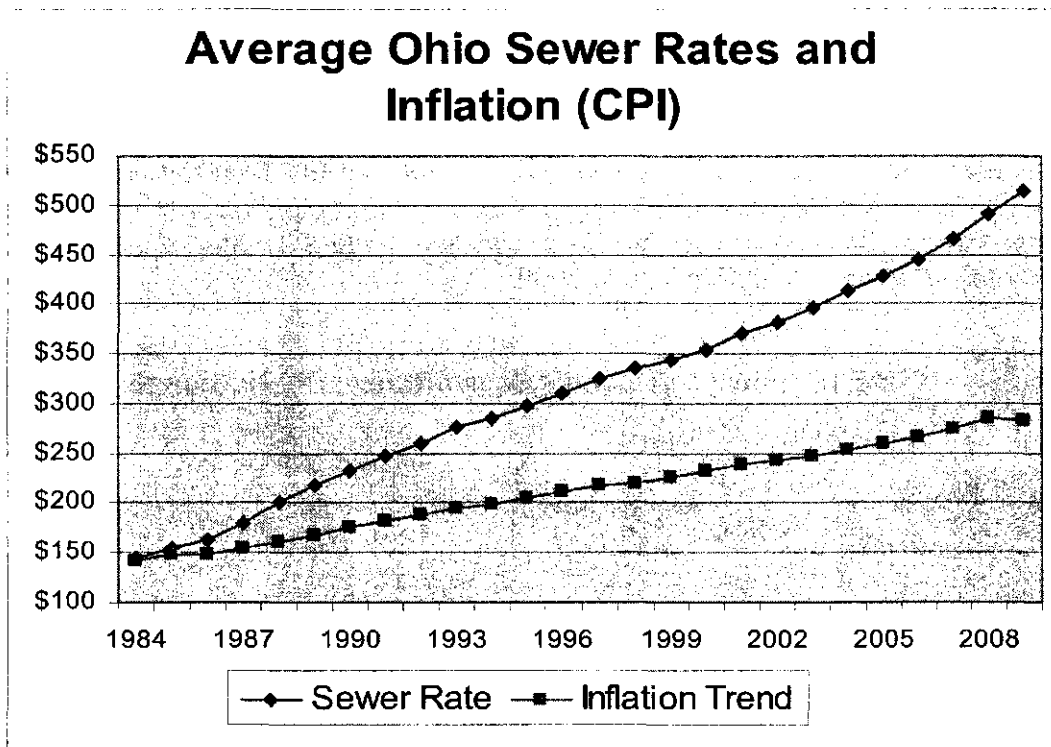


Figure 1: Annual Sewer Rates and Inflation 1984-2009

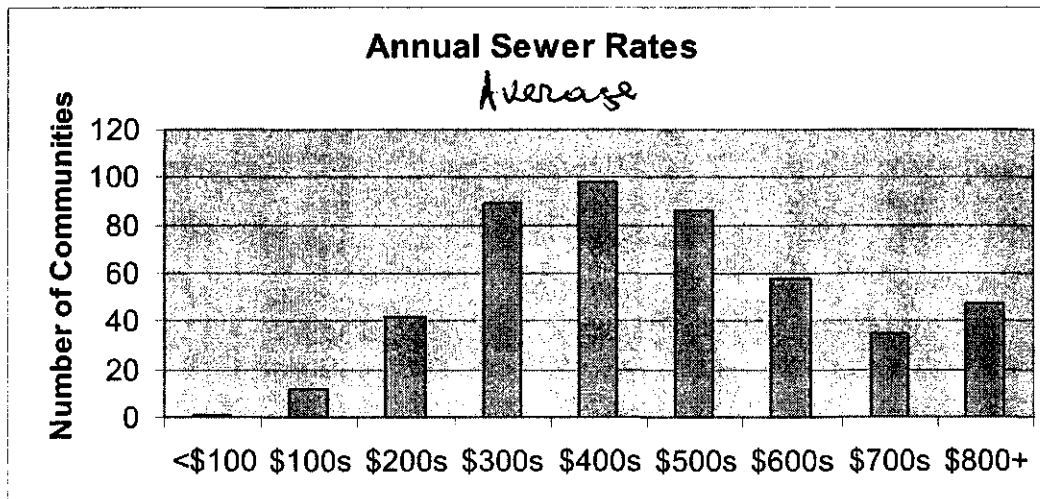


Figure 2: Sewer Rate Distribution in 2009

The 2009 average annual residential sewer rate in Ohio was \$514, a 4.5% increase over 2008. Half of all sewer systems charged rates lower than \$488 per year. Table 1 shows annual sewer rate averages for 1983 through 2009, along with the percentage change in average rates and the consumer price index (CPI-U: Midwest urban prices for all items). Figure 1 displays average annual sewer rate data and a trend line adjusting the base year (1984) average sewer rate for inflation. Figure 2 displays the range of sewer rates charged by communities in 2009.

Water Rates

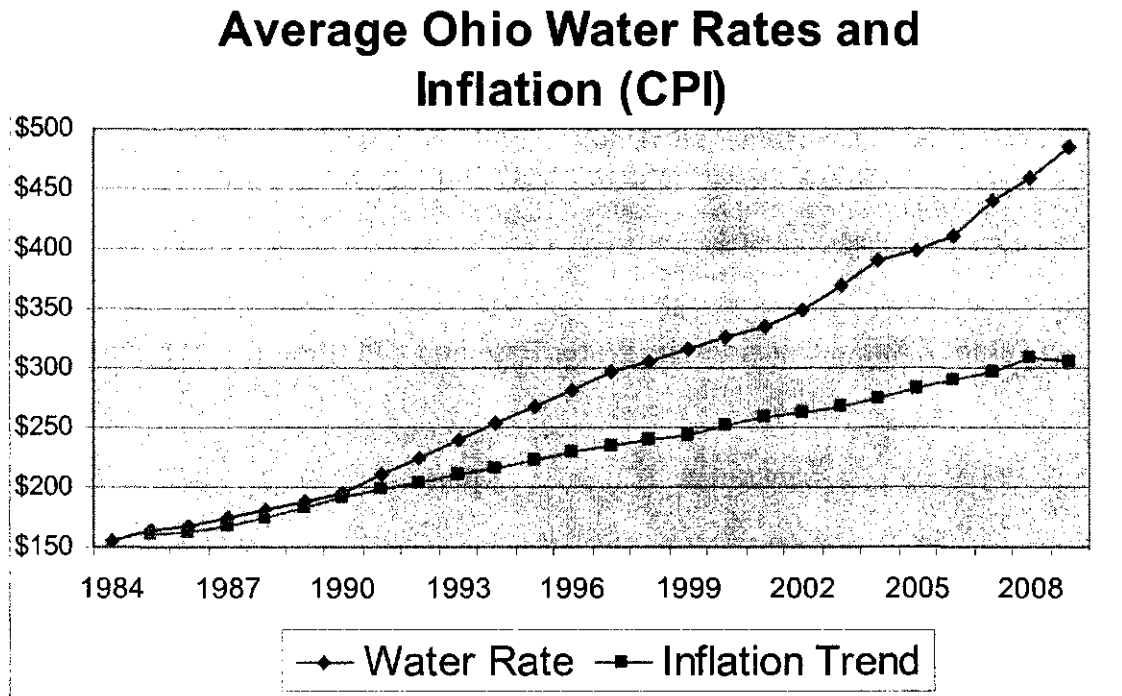


Figure 3: Annual Water Rates and Inflation 1985-2009

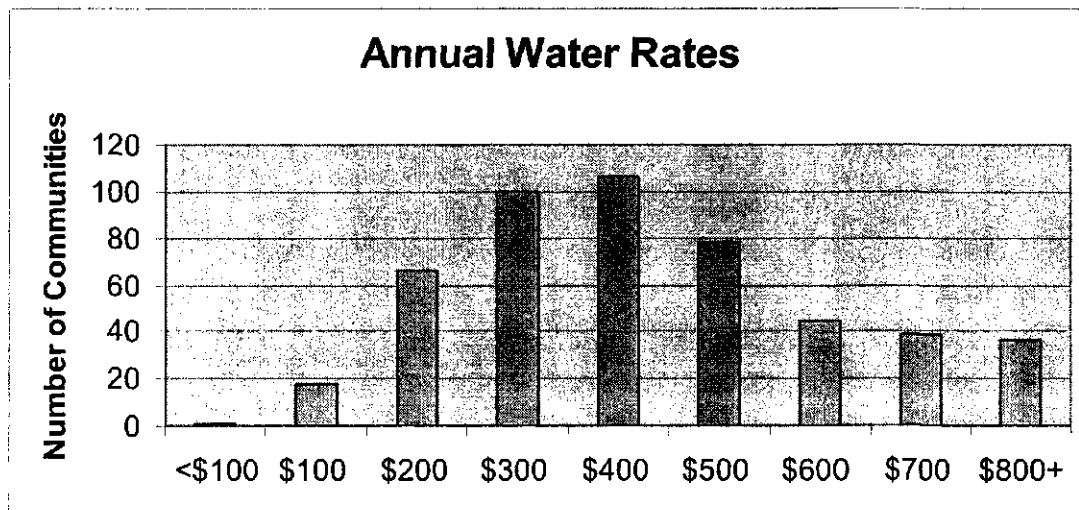


Figure 4: Water Rate Distribution in 2009

The 2009 average annual residential water rate in Ohio was \$484, a 5.7% increase over 2008. Half of all water systems charged rates lower than \$450. Table 2 displays annual water rate data for 1984 through 2009, along with the percentage change in average rates and the consumer price index (CPI-U: Midwest urban prices for all items). Figure 3 displays average annual water rate data and a trend line adjusting the base year (1985) average water rate for inflation. Figure 4 displays the range of water rates charged by communities in 2009.

Of 488 water systems, 253, or 52%, reported a rate increase during 2009.

Tap-in Fees

Appendix 4 contains the sewer and water tap-in fees submitted by respondents for residential customers inside and outside municipal limits. The fees are generally presented as they were reported on the questionnaires, without correction or interpretation. As a result, they may not be comparable across communities.

For example, some of the reported tap-in fees included labor and installation charges. Whereas other reported tap-in fees included only an administrative fee with the customer being held responsible for hiring their own private contractor to install the lines and taps. Finally, in other cases, tap-in fees were used as a source of revenue for debt repayment, or as a mechanism for new customers to pay towards the capital costs of the existing system.
