Dear Ms. Bowser:

On Tuesday, April 24, 2012, the Board staff was notified by company personnel of a blade failure that day at turbine location 68. Staff inspected the site of the incident and confirmed that the site is secure and there are no immediate safety issues. Furthermore, staff confirmed that project operations have been indefinitely suspended while Paulding Wind II LLC and the turbine manufacturer, Vestas, investigate the incident. Staff understands that Paulding Wind II will produce an investigation report at the conclusion of the investigation and staff expects this report to be filed on this docket. Staff will continue to monitor the project to ensure that Paulding Wind II LLC is in compliance with the Certificate. Please keep us advised of any updates.
