The purpose of this filing is to reduce rates for Terminating Switched Access in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission in its Report and Order in Docket Nos. 10-90, etc., FCC Release No. 11-161 issued November 18, 2011. Although the Order requires carriers to reduce rates by 50% of the differential between the carrier's interstate and intrastate rates Sprint will reduce its Terminating rates to parity with interstate access rates effective July 1, 2012. The Terminating Direct Connect Local Switching rates for Embarq Local Operating Companies and Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company will remain at the intrastate rate because it is lower than the interstate rate; moving to interstate would result in an increase which is not allowed under this FCC Order.
