ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On December 14, 2011, Mr. Dustin Foster (complainant) filed a complaint against The Dayton Power & Light Company (DP&L). In his complaint, Mr. Foster alleges that a DP&L equipment failure led to the damage of his personal property.
- (2) On December 20, 2011, DP&L filed an answer and a motion to dismiss.
- (3) By entry issued February 6, 2012, the attorney examiner scheduled a settlement conference for March 1, 2012.
- (4) On April 13, 2012, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss. The parties explain that they have entered into a full and comprehensive settlement and have resolved all claims and issues to their mutual satisfaction. The parties, therefore, request that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (5) Upon being advised by the parties that the issues raised by the complaint have been resolved, the Commission concludes that the joint motion to dismiss with prejudice is reasonable and is hereby granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, in accordance with Finding (5), the joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
