The Applicant, **Continental Telephone Company**, hereby modifies its Intrastate Access Service Tariff in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission's Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed rulemaking, WC Docket Nos. 10-90, et al., FCC 11-161 (Released Nov. 18, 2011), as well as the Commission's February 29, 2012 Entry in Case No. 10-2387-TP-COI with respect to intercarrier compensation.
