ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 8, 2012, Dr. Glenn D. Ritchie filed a complaint against American Electric Power (AEP or company) concerning a proposed rate increase by the company.
- (2) On March 27, 2012, AEP filed an answer and motion to dismiss in this matter. In its pleading, AEP stated that it has fully resolved the matter raised in the complaint. Further, AEP indicated that the complaint may be dismissed as a settled case under Rule 4901-9-01(F), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (3) Rule 4901-9-01(F), O.A.C., provides that, if the public utility complained against files an answer or motion which asserts that the complaint has been satisfied and no response is filed within 20 days, the Commission may presume that satisfaction has occurred and dismiss the complaint. No response to AEP's motion has been filed. Accordingly, this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That this case be dismissed. It is, further,






