ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On May 3, 2012, Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (joint applicants) filed a joint application pursuant to Section 4928.31, Revised Code, seeking authority to recover certain specified phase-in costs and financing costs through the issuance of bonds payable from the collection of phase-in-recovery charges. As part of their application, joint applicants proposed tariff sheets and a proposed bill format.
- (2) Pursuant to the May 25, 2012 attorney examiner entry, initial and reply comments regarding the joint application are to be filed on by June 25, 2012, and July 9, 2012 respectively.
- (3) Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-10-22(C), Ohio Administrative Code, "[a]ny new bill format proposed by an electric utility shall be filed with the commission for approval. If an application for sample bill approval is not acted upon within forty-five calendar days, said sample shall be deemed approved on the forty-sixth day after the filing."
- (4) In order to allow for the Commission to fully review the joint application in its totality and in order to fully consider the entire record in this matter, including the forthcoming public comments, the automatic approval time frame regarding customer bill formats shall be suspended at this time.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval time frame be suspended in accordance with Finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.


