ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On June 16, 2010, the Commission certified Spark Energy, L.P. (Spark Energy or the applicant) to provide aggregation and power broker services within Ohio as a competitive retail electric services (CRES) provider, with an expiration date of June 10, 2012.
- (2) On June 7, 2012, Spark Energy filed a motion for an additional 30-day extension to file its certification renewal application, stating that there have been no material changes in its operations, the requested extension will not adversely affect any customers, and its failure to timely file for renewal was an inadvertent oversight.
- (3) The requested 30-day extension of the applicant's expiration is warranted so that its customers will not be adversely affected while its renewal application is under consideration. The applicant is, however, cautioned that it must file its renewal application by June 25, 2012, and all future renewals should be in compliance with Rule 4901:1-24-09, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.). Failure to do so could lead to certificate suspension or recession or to the assessment of civil forfeitures by the Commission.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Spark Energy's motion for an extension of the certificate expiration date be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Spark Energy file its renewal application by June 25, 2012. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


