## **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 1, 2011, Suburban Natural Gas Company (Suburban) filed the above-referenced self-complaint requesting that the Commission approve a demand side management (DSM) rider in its tariff.
- (2) A hearing on Suburban's self-complaint was held on June 12, 2012. At the conclusion of the hearing, neither Suburban nor Staff requested the opportunity to file a brief.
- (3) On June 13, 2012, Suburban filed a motion for permission to file post-hearing briefs. Suburban requested that the parties be permitted to file post-hearing briefs within 14 days of the filing of the hearing transcript and reply briefs, if any, within 10 days thereafter.
- (4) Upon review, the attorney examiner finds that the motion for permission to file post-hearing briefs should be granted, in part. Accordingly, on or before 10 calendar days of the filing of the transcript in this case, the parties may file a post-hearing brief. All such briefs shall be limited to 10 pages in length. No reply briefs shall be filed.

ORDERED, That Suburban's motion to file a post-hearing brief is granted as set forth in finding 4. It is, further,

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ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served all parties of record in this docket.
