ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The above-referenced complaint was filed on December 27, 2011. In the complaint, Anita Deal (Ms. Deal or complainant) alleged that The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) improperly charged her for electric usage at her residence.
- (2) On January 12, 2012, DP&L filed an answer denying the allegations in the complaint.
- (3) By entry dated May 1, 2012, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing conference in this case for June 1, 2012. However, the complainant did not attend or otherwise participate in the prehearing conference.
- (4) Under the circumstances, the examiner finds that the prehearing conference should be rescheduled. However, Ms. Deal is advised that, absent a settlement of the complaint, failure to attend the scheduled settlement conference may result in a recommendation that the Commission dismiss the case for lack of prosecution.
- (5) Accordingly, the settlement conference in this case should be rescheduled for July 11, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., in the offices of the Commission, conference room 1246, 12<sup>th</sup> floor, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


