The Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) is filing corrected pages to its Joint Brief filed on June 22, 2012. OCC has learned that it misinterpreted the meaning of certain percentage figures that FirstEnergy provided to the parties in its response to a discovery request from AEP Retail. (The information became marked as OCC Exhibit 8.) Using those figures, OCC misstated the potential increases that residential customers may expect to see under FirstEnergy's proposals in this case. Therefore, OCC and Citizen Power are re-filing their Joint Initial Brief to make the corrections that appear on pages 1, 3, 8, 16, 18, 19, 77, 86 and 87. OCC apologizes for this circumstance.
