Amendment to the Wireless Interconnection and Compensation Agreement between

Conneaut Telephone Company and Verizon Wireless

This is an Amendment ("Amendment") to the Wireless Interconnection and Compensation Agreement between Conneaut Telephone Company ("ILEC") and the entities listed on the signature page of this Amendment d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Verizon Wireless"), jointly the "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties, or their predecessors in interest, previously entered into an Interconnection Agreement (the "Agreement"), pursuant to 47 U.S.C. 251/252; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission, in an order released November 18, 2011, has provided that bill-and-keep shall be the default compensation arrangement between the Parties for the exchange of all Intra-MTA traffic, and that this is to be considered a change of law; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission, in an order released December 23, 2011, has provided that such bill-and-keep arrangements, when requested before July 1, 2012, shall become effective July 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS Verizon Wireless elects to apply a bill-and-keep arrangement to all Intra-MTA traffic between the Parties; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement contains a "change of law" provision that authorizes the Parties to amend the Agreement to comport with a change in law; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement to provide for a bill-and-keep arrangement, for the exchange of all Intra-MTA traffic between them, such bill-and-keep arrangement to become effective July 1, 2012;

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in this Amendment and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

Amendment Terms

- 1. From July 1, 2012, forward, all Local Telecommunications Traffic between the Parties shall be exchanged pursuant to a bill-and-keep arrangement, which means that neither Party shall charge the other for the transport and termination of the other's traffic
- 2. The Terminating Reciprocal Compensation Rates found in Attachment I Section 3 shall be changed to \$0.00 per minute of use.
- 3. The Verizon Wireless address for Notices found in Section 16.10 is deleted and replaced with the following:

"Verizon Wireless Attn: Network Interconnection 1120 Sanctuary Parkway Alpharetta, GA 30009 with copies to: Verizon Wireless Attn: Regulatory Counsel - Interconnect 1300 I Street NW, Suite 400W Washington, DC 20005 Fax: 202.589.3750"

- 4. This Amendment shall be effective July 1, 2012.
- 5. This Amendment shall remain effective as long as the Agreement remains effective between the Parties.
- 6. The provisions of this Amendment, including the provisions of this sentence, may not be amended, modified or supplemented without the written consent thereto by both Parties' authorized representatives.
- 7. Except as expressly set forth herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect without change.

The Parties, intending to be legally bound, have executed this Amendment as of the dates set forth below, in multiple counterparts, each of which is deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.
