ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 19, 2012, as supplemented on January 20, 2012, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke), filed an application, pursuant to Section 4909.18, Revised Code, for authority to cancel its Spark Spread Interruptible Transportation Rate.
- (2) By entry issued on July 6, 2012, the attorney examiner granted the motion to intervene filed by the University of Cincinnati (UC) and scheduled a conference in this case for August 9, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission.
- (3) On August 6, 2012, Duke and UC file a joint motion for continuance of the conference, which is scheduled for August 9, 2012. In support of their request, the joint movants state that they have recently jointly filed an application in Case No. 12-2171-GA-AEC (12-2171), which may satisfy the concerns raised by UC and the interests of Duke in this case. Therefore, the joint movants request that the conference be suspended pending the outcome of the application filed in 12-2171.
- (4) Upon consideration of the joint motion for continuance of the conference scheduled in this case, the attorney examiner finds that it is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the joint motion for continuance be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all interested persons of record in this case.
