ENTRY

The Attorney Examiner finds:

- (1) On May 31, 2012, the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) filed a notice of intent to file an application to adjust the Universal Service Fund (USF) riders of all Ohio jurisdictional electric distribution utilities.
- (2) Pursuant to the procedural entry issued July 5, 2012, motions to intervene and objections or comments to the notice of intent to file an application were due by July 27, 2012, and replies to any objections or comments filed were due by August 3, 2012.
- (3) Timely motions to intervene in this matter were filed by Ohio Partners for Affordable Energy (OPAE), Industrial Energy Users-Ohio (IEU), and the Office of Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC). All of the motions to intervene assert a real and substantial interest that is not represented by another party to this matter. Further, each motion asserts that the disposition of this case may impair or impede the party's ability to protect that interest. No party filed a memorandum contra any of the motions to intervene.
- (4) The Attorney Examiner finds that OPAE, IEU, and OCC each have a real and substantial interest in this case and, therefore, their respective motions for intervention should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motions to intervene filed by OPAE, IEU, and OCC are granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served on all parties of record in this case.
