MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

On July 9, 2012, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. ("Duke") filed an Application for Increase in Gas Distribution Rates, an Application for Tariff Approval, an Application for an Alternative Rate Plan, and an Application for Approval to Change Accounting Methods.
