# APPLICATION OF FIBERNET OF OHIO, LLC TO WITHDRAW THE PROVISION OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN THE CIRCLEVILLE AND JACKSON, OHIO EXCHANGE AREAS

FiberNet of Ohio, LLC, ("FiberNet" or "Applicant"), through its attorney, hereby respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO") grant this Application to withdraw the provision of local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in the local exchange areas of Circleville and Jackson, Ohio effective November 15, 2012. In support of said Application, FiberNet represents the following:

- 2. FiberNet of Ohio, LLC ("FiberNet"), is a facilities-based CLEC authorized by the PUCO to provide competitive telecommunications services in select markets within the current AT&T and Frontier North ILEC service areas in Ohio through PUCO Certificate No. 90-9201.
- 3. For strategic, business and economic reasons, FiberNet desires to withdraw its continued provision of local and interexchange telecommunications services to current customers in the Jackson and Circleville, Ohio exchange areas effective November 15, 2012, and to thereafter close its collocation arrangements in the Jackson and Circleville central offices both of which are located in the current Frontier North service territory in Ohio.
- 4. As of the time of this filing, FiberNet has 9 business customers with a total of 19 access lines in the Circleville exchange, and 7 business customers with a total of 25 access lines in the Jackson exchange.
- 5. It is FiberNet's intention to give affected customers in the Circleville and Jackson exchange areas written notification via direct mail and a period of forty-five (45) days in which to either disconnect or migrate service without penalty to an alternative telecommunications service provider. A copy of the customer notification letter, which is scheduled to be mailed out to affected customers on or about September 27, 2012, is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 6. FiberNet will return any deposits previously collected from the affected customers by on or before December 15, 2012.
- 7. At present, FiberNet has assigned to it the 740-207-8000-8999 number block in the Circleville exchange area, and the 740-395-9000-9999 number block in the Jackson exchange area. Upon the orderly migration of its customers and the subsequent closure of the Circleville and Jackson collocation arrangements, FiberNet will timely return the aforementioned thousand blocks to the North American Numbering Plan pooling administrator.
- 8. Despite its instant request to withdraw the provision of telecommunications services in the Circleville and Jackson, Ohio exchange areas, FiberNet will continue to provide competitive telecommunications services to all of its other customers presently located in the State of Ohio in accordance with PUCO Certificate No. 90-9201.
- 9. Since FiberNet is only requesting to withdraw the continued provision of telecommunications service to a small group of current customers in the designated local exchange areas of Circleville and Jackson, Ohio, and will continue to provide competitive telecommunications service to its other customers in Ohio, no changes or other modifications to its formal tariffs in Ohio are necessary at this time.

WHEREFORE, for all of the reasons herein stated, FiberNet of Ohio, LLC respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio grant its Application to withdraw the provision of telecommunications services to customers located in the Circleville and Jackson, Ohio local exchange areas effective November 15, 2012, along with such other relief as the PUCO may deem just and proper.
