#### Memorandum in Support of Application.

#### Introduction

United Telephone of Ohio d/b/a CenturyLink ("CenturyLink") submits this information and analysis in support of its application filed in the captioned case. This application is filed pursuant to R. C. § 4927.12(C)(3)(a) (effective September 13, 2010), which provides as follows:

If the commission has not made a prior determination that the exchange area qualified for alternative regulation of basic local exchange service under Chapter 4901:1-4 of the Ohio Administrative Code as that chapter existed on the effective date of this section, an incumbent local exchange carrier may not alter its rates for basic local exchange service upward for that exchange area unless the carrier first applies to the commission and the commission determines that the application demonstrates that two or more alternative providers offer, in the exchange area, competing service to the basic local exchange service offered by an incumbent local exchange carrier in the exchange area, regardless of the technology and facilities used by the alternative provider, the alternative provider's location, and the extent of the alternative provider's service area within the exchange area. An alternative provider includes a telephone company, including a wireless service provider, a telecommunications carrier, and a provider of internet protocol-enabled services, including voice over internet protocol.

CenturyLink has not previously filed for alternative regulation of basic local exchange service under Chapter 4901:1-4 of the Ohio Administative code for any of these exchanges – Adamsville, Adario, Alexandria, Apple Creek, Belleville, Big Prairie, Bucyrus, Butler, Caledonia, Cardington, Centerburg, Chatfield, Chesterville, Crooksville, Croton, Danville, Frazeyburg, Fredericksburg, Fredericktown, Gambier, Glenmont, Glouster, Holmesville, Johnsville, Junction City, Kidron, Killbuck, Lucas, Luckey, Lykens, Marengo, Marshallville, Martinsburg, McConnelsville, Millersburg, Nashville, New Winchester, Reinersville, Rittman, Shiloh, Shreve, Sterling, Stockport – included in this application. Thus, the Commission has not made a prior determination that any of these exchanges is qualified for alternaive regulation. Further, the application demonstates that two or more alternative providers offer service in each of the exhanges in competition with the basic exchange service offered by CenturyLink. Because the application meets the statuatory requirements of R.C. 4927.12(C)(3)(a), as demonstatrated in the attached Exhibits, CenturyLink request that the Commission issue an order granting this application. Alternatively, CenturyLink requests that the Commission allow the application to be granted under the automatic approval process set forth in R.C. 4927.12(C)(3)(b), which provides as follows:

Upon the filing of an application under division (C)(3)(a) of this section, the commission shall be deemed to have found that the application meets the requirements of that division unless the commission, within thirty days after the filing of the application, issues an order finding that the requirements have not been met.

Furthermore, CenturyLink recognizes the pricing restrictions on basic local exchange service ("BLES") included in this filing as set forth in R.C. 4927.12(C)(3)(c). R.C. 4927.12(C)(3)(c) provides the following:

In no event may an incumbent local exchange carrier that applies to the commission under division (C)(3)(a) of this section, during the twelve-month period that begins on the thirty-first day after the company files the application, and during any subsequent twelvemonth period, alter the carrier's rates for basic local exchange service upward for the exchange area to which the application applies by more than the amount described in division (C)(1)(b) of this section.

#### Exhibit 1 - Exchange Areas/County

This exhibit identifies the exchanges included in this application and the county or counties in which each exchange is located.

#### Exhibit 2 - Supporting Competitive Information with Affidavit

CenturyLink demonstrates in this exhibit that it meets statutory criterion that two or more alternative providers offer competing service to the BLES service offered by CenturyLink in each of the exchanges included in this application. CenturyLink reviewed publically available information of alternative providers offering competing service in each exchange via the competitor's websites. The alternative carriers have web tools that permit one to determine the availability of the carrier's services in specific areas based on a phone number and/or address. These tools enable one to readily verify that alternative services are offered in an area and the specific service options available to customers. In addition wireless carriers have Coverage Locator sites which display the strength of service at a given location. CenturyLink utilized these tools to identify the service offerings and some of the providers within each exchange. (NOTE: CenturyLink was unable to print color images of some of the AT&T Coverage Viewer pages. See <u>http://www.wireless.att.com/coverageviewer/#?type=voice</u>

The competitive information CenturyLink obtained from these tools is summarized at the beginning of the exhibit. This summary does not represent all the alternative providers or services available in an exchange, but demonstrates that there are two or more carriers that offer a variety of service plans and technologies in the exchanges.

The exhibit also contains the affidavit of Gary Baki attesting that the information set forth in the exhibit is true and correct to the best of CenturyLink's knowledge.

CenturyLink has demonstrated that it meets the statutory requirements for BLES price flexibility in each of the exchanges included in this application. The Commission should either issue an order approving this application or allow the application to be granted by operation of law.
