COMPLAINT DESCRIPTION:

Hello I am writing to protest the Buckeye Wind Project, owned by EverPower. This project is highly experimental and there are no guarantees whatsoever that property values will not suffer and residents' health

will not suffer. Residents have a right to not live withing a half mile of these huge industrial size wind turbines. Study after study has shown that there are very real health, economic and ecological impacts in residential areas where these turbines are "planted."

EverPower has hidden behind a veil of secrecy for years as they have infiltrated the community using Farm Bureau resources. Many of the lease holders will not live near the turbines they are agreeing to "host" and have no personal investment in the effect these turbines may have. Lease holder names were released grudgingly after Sunshine Laws etc were provoked and EverPower continues to cry fowl when any evidence is brought up that combats the rosy fantasy they are pushing on our community.

EverPower is owned by a foreign company, sucking up our federal tax dollars. The jobs this project will provide have been overblown to take advantage of a poor economy. Many communities in NY, PA, and WI have wind turbines up and have not experienced this mythical injection of cash into their local economies.

EverPower representatives have freely admitted in past hearing that they "don't know" what will happen when these turbines are up. It doesn't matter if they truly don't know or won't say, either way, they refuse to speak to what they will do if residents experience unusual health symptoms they have previously never experienced or is we observe drops in certain bird and bat populations. There is never any talk of "making it right" is this experiment fails.
