PETITION OF CLEVELAND UNLIMITED, INC. FOR REVIEW OF A DECISION OF THE POOLING ADMINISTRATOR

Cleveland Unlimited, Inc. d/b/a Revol Wireless ("Revol") hereby submits this Petition requesting that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the "Commission") review the Pooling Administrator's (the "PA's" or "Neustar's") denial of Revol's request for numbering resources in the Columbia Station, Ohio rate center. As set forth in greater detail below, Revol respectfully requests that the Commission overturn the PA's decision and direct it to assign the requested number block to Revol.

On October 22, 2012, Revol filed a request with Neustar for a thousands-block of numbers within the Columbia Station rate center.¹ Specifically, Revol requested 1,000 numbers in order to obtain the dedicated number range necessary to install a new switch on its network. However, Neustar denied Revol's request on the grounds that Revol had not satisfied the months-to-exhaust and utilization criteria established in the Central Office Code Assignment Guidelines.² Under the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC's") numbering rules, a state regulatory body, like the Commission, can overturn a PA's decision based on its

¹ To facilitate the Commission's review of its request, Revol has attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u>, a copy of its request to Neustar, which includes the MTE and Utilization Certification Worksheet. ² The denial notification from Neustar is attached hereto as Exhibit B. determination that the petitioning carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for the numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies.³ As demonstrated herein, the Commission is fully justified in overturning Neustar's decision and granting Revol's request for a new thousands-block.

As part of the process of upgrading its wireless network, Revol is installing faster and more efficient switches to support its network modernization efforts. As the Commission is aware, industry practices and Local Exchange Routing Guide standards require that each switch on a network have a dedicated number range, and Revol's request for a new thousands-block of numbers is intended to satisfy this requirement. The need for new blocks of numbers to satisfy industry requirements for the installation of new switches is well-documented. Indeed, the FCC has explicitly recognized the fact that "new numbering resources are used by carriers to activate new switches" and has installed a safety valve process in order to ensure that carriers have access to the numbers that they need to activate new switches.⁴ Specifically, the FCC permits states "to consider requests from carriers with multiple switches in a given rate center to determine whether relief is warranted" from a PA's decision not to provide numbering resources.⁵ In this instance, Revol's network modernization project requires a new switch, which will deliver faster, more efficient services to new and existing Revol customers in the Columbus Station rate center. As discussed above, installation of this new switch requires a new thousands-block of numbers, and, as such, the provision of this thousands-block of numbers is a necessary step in Revol's network modernization efforts.

The PA is Revol's only source for this necessary new block of numbers, and Revol has thus exhausted any other alternative options for relief. Revol is, of course, mindful of the need to preserve scarce numbering resources. In order to use its assigned numbers in the most efficient manner, Revol is pursuing the use of a pooled block, and has requested the thousands-block from a pooled "A block" that Revol currently owns.

For the reasons set forth above, and for good cause shown, Revol respectfully requests that the Commission overturn Neustar's decision and direct Neustar to grant Revol's request for the thousands-block in order to allow Revol to proceed with its network modernization plans.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section.
