  - Q. Can you please describe what that document is?
  - A. That is Suburban Natural Gas' Gas Cost Recovery Audit for the period of March 2010 through February 29th, 2012.
  - Q. And were you responsible for this document?
    - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. And do you have before you what's been marked for purposes of identification as
  Commission-Ordered Exhibit No. 2?

A. Yes, sir.

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- Q. Would you please describe that document?
- A. That is Suburban Natural Gas'
  Uncollectible Expense Rider Audit for the period of
  January 2009 through December 2011.
  - Q. And were you also responsible for the preparation of this document?
    - A. Yes, sir.
  - Q. Finally, Mr. Sarver, do you have before you what's been marked as Joint Exhibit No. 1?
    - A. Yes, sir.
    - Q. And what is that document, please?
- A. That is the Joint Stipulation and Recommendation between the Commission and Suburban.
- Q. Were you involved at all in the negotiation of this agreement?
  - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Mr. Sarver, if I asked you to turn to the second unnumbered page of Joint Exhibit No. 1, Paragraph A3, it describes a Financial Audit performed. Is this the document you have previously identified as Commission-Ordered Exhibit 1?
  - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. If I ask you to turn to unnumbered Page 6 of Joint Exhibit No. 1, Paragraph B1, it describes

- there an audit of the Uncollectible Expense
  Mechanism. Is that the document you previously
  identified as Commission-Ordered Exhibit No. 2?
  - A. Yes, sir.

- Q. Mr. Sarver, in your opinion, was this Joint Stipulation and Recommendation entered into between knowledgeable and capable parties?
  - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. In your opinion, does this agreement promote the public interest?
- A. Yes. This Stipulation adopts the findings of both the Gas Cost Recovery Audit in Exhibit 1 and the UEX Audit in Exhibit 2. The recommendations that were made by Staff are being adopted in the Stipulation.
- Q. And how does that promote the public interest, sir?
- A. Because what it does is these audits are intended to safeguard customers along with provide the utility the opportunity to recover the costs that's incurred on a dollar-for-dollar basis. If there are any errors or mistakes made, what the Staff is attempting to do is to identify those errors and correct those, so that the Company, along with customers, are compensated for -- the Company is

- compensated for the costs it incurred. The customers pay only the costs that they're responsible to pay.
- Q. And there were, in fact, some adjustments recommended; is that correct, sir?
- A. Yes. The other point of these audits is to go back and ensure that any prior

  Commission-ordered recommendation has been adopted by the Company and put into effect.
  - Q. And that review was also performed?
  - A. Yes, sir.

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- Q. And recommendations in that regard were also made and adopted; is that correct?
  - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Finally, Mr. Sarver, in your opinion, does this agreement violate any regulatory practice or principle with which you are familiar?
- 17 A. No, sir.
  - MR. MARGARD: Your Honor, with that, I conclude my examination of Mr. Sarver and offer him for cross-examination.
