**1. APPLICANT RESPECTFULLY PROPOSES:**

**2. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:**

The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (“DEO”) proposes to revise its General Terms and Conditions of Energy Choice Pooling Service (“ECPS”), including the Energy Choice Pooling Service Agreement, to conform to existing practices and reflect supplier recommendations as discussed below.

- A. DEO proposes to delete the requirement for suppliers to specify firm receipt points as part of the Service Agreement. *See* Second Revised Sheet F-ECPS 4, Second Revised Sheet F-ECPS 7, First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 20.
- B. DEO proposes to delete the option for a supplier to have DEO remarket assigned on-system storage capacity or for the supplier to use such capacity in other pooling services with DEO. *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 5; First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 17.

- C. DEO proposes to shorten the period when suppliers must demonstrate comparable capacity to November through March and to adjust the amount of certain released capacity as a supplier's customer demand changes. *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 13; First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 15; First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 17.
- D. DEO proposes to delete the requirement for it to provide a list of end-use customer accounts served by a supplier's pool and to change the timing of when DEO will provide aggregate daily consumption volume projections. *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 33.
- E. DEO proposes to delete the alternate options for suppliers to estimate customer delivery volumes and to delete DEO's reservation of the right to use the current month's data to project consumption during operational-flow-order ("OFO") periods. *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 34.
- F. DEO proposes to reflect the daily trading imbalance fee as \$95.60 "plus applicable gross receipts tax." The total charge of \$100.00 will not change. *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 35.
- G. DEO proposes to delete language stating when month-end imbalance trading typically occurs, delete parenthetical examples of month-end imbalance trading, add a requirement for suppliers to submit invoices of positive imbalances to DEO, and add a requirement for DEO to pay submitted invoices within fifteen days of posting. *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 38.
- H. DEO proposes to delete the current provisions addressing electronic file transfers in their entirety. In its place, DEO proposes to add language requiring DEO to receive enrollments every business day, to process the enrollments overnight and

provide results the next business day, and to provide more information concerning the enrollment process in the Enrollment/Billing File Specifications document.

- I. DEO also proposes various administrative changes including:
  - i. changing page numbers on the tariff Table of Contents to reflect the proposed revisions. *See First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 1; First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 2.*
  - ii. updating the title of Jeffrey A. Murphy. *See Second Revised Sheet No. F-ECPS 6.*
  - iii. indicating that in the revised tariffs, the page that was Second Revised Sheet No. F-ECPS 7 is now left intentionally blank. *See Second Revised Sheet No. F-ECPS 7.*
  - iv. correcting the spelling of “superseded.” *See First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 22; First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 23; First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 24; First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 57.*
  - v. aligning a column of percentages. *See First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 28.*
  - vi. deleting an extra space. *See First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 34; First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 42.*
  - vii. adding the word “From” and capitalizing “Over.” *See First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 36.*
  - viii. correcting a paragraph reference. *See First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 42; Second Revised Sheet F-ECPS 64; First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 65.*

- ix. correcting the second paragraph numbered 23.17 to 23.18. *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 45.
- x. deleting a duplicate word. *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 48.
- xi. clarifying that the ECTS tariff is segregated for residential and non-residential customers, and changing the word “those” to “its.” *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 50.
- iii. deleting reference to Ohio Adm. Code subsections that are no longer applicable due to rule changes. *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 50; Second Revised Sheet F-ECPS 64.
- xii. changing the year reference from “200\_” to “20\_\_.” *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 60; Second Revised Sheet F-ECPS 62.
- iv. deleting the DEO contact person because the employee no longer works for DEO. *See* First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 61; Second Revised Sheet F-ECPS 63; First Revised Sheet F-ECPS 66.
- J. DEO proposes to make the following administrative changes to all tariff sheets:
  - i. Revise the form of the tariff sheet numbers to exclude the prefix “F,” which is no longer meaningful, and add the abbreviation “No.” between “Sheet” and the sheet number where it does not already appear.
  - ii. Correct the spelling of “Superseding” in the sheet headers.
  - iii. Indicate that the proposed tariffs are authorized by Anne E. Bomar, Senior Vice President, who replaced Bruce C. Klink.
