## <u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1)On August 17, 2012, Louis E. Fisher (complainant) filed a complaint against Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia) alleging that he was unnecessarily charged by Columbia for the cost of running a new line to his home. Specifically, in seeking service for a newly built home, complainant states that he contacted Columbia's new business team and was informed that he would need a 230 foot two-inch main line; however, according to complainant, 100 feet of the line would be provided at no cost to complainant, per Columbia's policies. Upon contacting Columbia again to ascertain the status of the project, complainant explains he was informed the project was put on hold, as complainant would need to pay \$2,228.00 to cover complainant's 130-foot portion of the 230-foot main line. On September 10, 2012, Columbia filed its answer to the complaint.
- (2) A settlement conference was held on October 9, 2012.
- (3) On November 6, 2012, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss this case. In the motion, the parties assert that they have resolved all of the issues raised in this case.
- (4) In light of the parties' November 6, 2012, motion, the Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint, given that they have reached an agreement which resolves the issues raised in the complaint, is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties' request to dismiss the complaint be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 12-2342-GA-CSS be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
