- (1) On March 6, 2012, Enterprise Liquids Pipeline LLC (ELP) filed a letter opening a docket in anticipation of filing a preapplication motion for waivers for an ethane pipeline. ELP filed its motion for waivers on March 7, 2012.
- (2) On September 17, 2012, ELP filed a request to withdraw this case, stating that, in light of the recent passage of Ohio Senate Bill 315, a certificate from the Board is not required for the construction of an ethane pipeline, as the project would not meet the definition of a major utility facility.
- (3) Upon consideration of ELP's request, the Board finds that the instant case should be dismissed and closed of record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That ELP's request to withdraw this case be granted and Case No. 12-862-PL-ACE be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,
