## **QUESTION DESCRIPTION:**

Comment: My Dec 11 2012 billing rate (\$0.0943/KWH) was 30% higher than my Dec 11 2011 billing rate (\$0.0726). 20% of that 30% rate increase was attributed to riders approved by PUCO.

Question: Is there available a reasonably understandable comparison of the rate increases over the last 12 months for residential, industrial, and commercial electric power available?
