### The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 8, 2012, Ms. Harriet Shasby filed a complaint against the respondent, Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison), alleging that she was overcharged for electric service to her home.
- (2) Ohio Edison filed an answer to the complaint on August 28, 2012. On November 19, 2012, Ohio Edison filed a motion to dismiss this matter. In its motion to dismiss, Ohio Edison alleges that the parties have fully resolved the matter raised in the complaint. Further, Ohio Edison indicates that the complaint may be dismissed as a settled case under Rule 4901-9-01(F), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (3) Rule 4901-9-01(F), O.A.C., provides that, if the public utility complained against files an answer or motion which asserts that the complaint has been satisfied and no response is filed within 20 days, the Commission may presume that satisfaction has occurred and dismiss the complaint. No response to Ohio Edison's motion to dismiss has been filed. Accordingly, this case should be dismissed.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case be dismissed. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served on each party of record.


