MOTION OF BUCKEYE TELESYSTEM, INC. FOR REVIEW OF A DECISION OF THE NORTH AMERICAN NUMBERING POOLING ADMINISTRATOR

Buckeye TeleSystem, Inc. ("Buckeye") is a certificated local exchange carrier providing service to primarily business customers in northwest Ohio. Buckeye has a customer, Mercy Health Partners ("Mercy Health"), a division of Catholic Health Partners that is opening up a new location in Perrysburg, Ohio that Buckeye plans to serve in the near future.

Mercy Health has requested that Buckeye provide it with a block of 4,000 numbers that will satisfy all of its needs. The new location in Perrysburg, Ohio is starting out as an Emergency Department and then will be evolving into a medical office building as well as a hospital. Mercy Health believes that the 4,000 block will be able to cover all its telecommunications needs.

Attachment B consists of the Thousands-Block Application Form – Part 1A for tracking

number 567-Perrysburg-OH-599137 which was prepared by Buckeye.

Buckeye has submitted a request to the Pooling Administrator which was denied on

January 7, 2013. The explanation for the denial given was as follows:

DR-57: You do not meet the MTE and/or utilization requirements, therefore this request for a new block is denied. You may proceed with requesting a State Waiver from the appropriate state commission using this Part 3 denial. If you are in disagreement

with the disposition of this request, please refer to the Thousands Block Number (NXX-X) Pooling Administration Guidelines for the appeals process.

Attachment D is a letter from Sally Makovic, Telecommunications, of the Catholic Health Partners.

It is reasonable for Mercy Health to request a block of 4,000 numbers that will satisfy its need and the need for residents in the community to be able to reach the emergency department, a medical office building, and a hospital.

The Commission has authority to review the PAS decision and issue a waiver to PAS authorizing assignment of the NPA-NXXs requested by Buckeye.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Buckeye respectfully requests that the Commission or its Attorney Examiner act expeditiously and issue an Order providing a waiver to the PAS and authorizing assignment of the numbering resources that Buckeye has requested on behalf of the Mercy Health Partners, a division of Catholic Health Partners.

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator s name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for

an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the TelcordiaTM LERGTM Routing Guide.
