

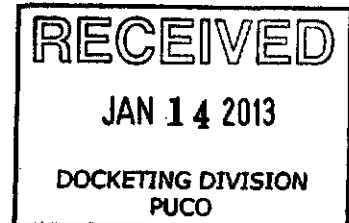

COMPLAINT DESCRIPTION:

I am protesting PUCO's decision not to fund the Zanesville Solar Project. I experienced losses after last summer's derecho storm which were not reimbursed by insurance.
