I am writing this letter to state my final thoughts on this case and my requests for compensation, after the hearing. On page 23 of the transcript, Dominion East Ohio (DEO) never notified me that the gas at 665 N. Bever St. had been running up to \$4,999. They now have given me a shut off notice for another property in Wooster for \$150. Secondly, they moved the gas bill from the Bever property to 439 N. Market St., also in Wooster, without notifying me. I found out when the gas was turned off there. How do they have the right to transfer this bill? I lost rent from both properties and eventually, 439 N. Market St. property. I am an independent property owner who cannot with stand financial hardship due to DEO's lack of professionalism. My request for reimbursement; (1) Lost rents \$53,000 (2) Lost property (439 N. Market St.) \$75,000. Thank you for your time.
