ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- On January 15, 2013, Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc. (Vectren) filed an application seeking approval of a Tri-Party Capacity Release Agreement. In the application, Vectren explains that it is proposing revisions to its gas service tariff that will incorporate language addressing mandatory capacity release requirements.
- (2) On January 18, 2013, Vectren filed a letter stating that after filing the aforementioned application, it identified additional changes that are necessary for the proposed tariff revisions. Vectren proposes to file a new application with proposed tariff sheets reflecting the additional changes. Consequently, states Vectren, it seeks to withdraw its January 15, 2013, application.
- (3) The Commission finds Vectren's request to withdraw its application to be reasonable, and therefore, it should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Vectren's request to withdraw its January 15, 2013, application filed in this case be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
