

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohlo (PUCO) has scheduled local public frearings in Case Nos. 12-1682-EL-AIR, 12-1683-EL-ATA, and 12-1684-EL-AAM, in the Matter of the Application of Duke Energy Ohlo, inc., for an increase in its Electric Distribution Rates, for Tarliff Approval, and for Approval to Change Accounting Methods (Electric Rate Case) and Case Nos. 12-1685-GA-AIR, 12-1686-GA-ATA, 12-1687-GA-AIT, and 12-1688-GA-AAM, in the Matter of the Application of Duke Energy Ohlo, inc. for an increase in its Natural Gas Distribution Rates, for Tarliff Approval, for Approval of an Alternative Rate Plan for Gas Distribution Service, and for Approval to Change Accounting Methods (Gas Rate Case). These local hearings are scheduled for the purpose of providing an opportunity for interested members of the public to teetify in these proceedings. The local hearings will be held at the following times and locations: February 19, 2013, at 6:30 p.m., at the Falifield Township Administrative Building, 6032 Morris Road, Hamilton, Ohlo 45011; February 20, 2013 at 6:30 p.m., at the Union Township Civic Center Hall, 4350 Alcholtz Road, Cincinnati, Ohlo 45245; February 25, 2013, 6:30 p.m., at the City Building, City Council Chambers, Lower Level, 1. Donham Piaza, Middletown, Ohlo 45042; and February 28, 2013, 12:30 p.m., at Cincinnati, Ohlo 45202. The evidentiary hearing will commence on March 25, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, Hearing Room 13-A, 180 East Broad Street, Columbue, Ohlo 43215.

In the Electric Rate Case, Duke Energy Ohlo, Inc. (Duke) seeks a rate increase that would generate approximately \$86,581,974 of additional revenue, or an increase of 24,02 percent over current revenue. After its review of Duke's records and application, the staff of the Commission recommends a revenue increase of between \$37,168,986 to \$46,186,385, or an increase of 10.11 to 12,56 percent over current revenue. The major issues in the Electric Rate Case include:

- (a) Revenue requirements as impacted by rate base, operating income, and rate of return.
- (b) Establishment of a facilities relocation and transportation tariff and rider.
- (c) Establishment of a deferral mechanism to track storm costs.
- (d) Ameritzation of the balance of the regulatory assets.

In the Gas Hate Case, Duke seeks a rate increase that would generate approximately \$44,007,929 of additional revenue, or an increase of 18.09 percent over current revenue. Upon review, the staff of the Commission recommends a revenue decrease from current revenue of between \$10,725,809 and \$3,368,775, or a decrease from current revenue of between 2.80 and 0.88 percent. The major issued in the Gas Rate Case include:

- (a) Revenue requirements as impacted by rate base, operating income, and rate of return.
- (b) Establishment of various riders, including: accelerated service tine replacement program; facilities relocation and transportation; natural gas vehicle; gas generation interruptible transportation; and economic development.
- (c) Changing the charge for reconnection of service.
- (d) Amendments to the accelerated main replacement program and rider (AMRP) and implementation of a rider for replacements not covered under rider AMRP.
- (e) Continuation of its grid modernization initiative and rider.
- (f) Continuation of deferral authority for, and recovery of manufactured gas plant cleanup costs.

### **LEGAL NOTICE**

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) has scheduled local public hearings in Case Nos. 12-1682- EL-AIR, 12-1683-EL-ATA, and 12-1684-EL-AAM, In the Matter of the Application of Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., for an Increase in its Electric Distribution Rates, for Tariff Approval, and for Approval to Change Accounting Methods (Electric Rate Case) and Case Nos. 12-1685- GA-AIR, 12-1686-GA-ATA, 12-1687-GA-ALT, and 12- 1688-GA-AAM, In the Matter of the Application of Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. for an Increase in its Natural Gas Distribution Rates, for Tariff Approval, for Approval of an Alternative Rate Plan for Gas Distribution Service, and for Approval to Change Accounting Methods (Gas Rate Case). These local hearings are scheduled for the purpose of providing an opportunity for interested members of the public to testify in these proceedings. The local hearings will be held at the following times and locations: February 19, 2013, at 6:30 p.m., at the Fairfield Township Administrative Building, 6032 Morris Road, Hamilton, Ohio 45011; February 20, 2013 at 6:30 p.m., at the Union Township Civic Center Hall, 4350 Aicholtz Road, Cincinnati, Ohio 45245; February 25, 2013, 6:30 p.m., at the City Building, City Council Chambers, Lower Level, 1 Donham Plaza, Middletown, Ohio 45042; and February 28, 2013, 12:30 p.m., at Cincinnati City Hall, Council Chambers, 801 Plum Street, Cincinnati, Ohio 45202. The evidentiary hearing will commence on March 25, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, Hearing Room 11-A, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. In the Electric Rate Case, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke) seeks a rate increase that would generate approximately \$86,581,974 of additional revenue, or an increase of 24.02 percent over current revenue. After its review of Duke's records and application, the staff of the Commission recommends a revenue increase of between \$37,168,986 to \$46,166,385, or an increase of 10.11 to 12.56 percent over current revenue. The major issues in the Electric Rate Case include:

- (a) Revenue requirements as impacted by rate base, operating income, and rate of return.
  - (b) Establishment of a facilities relocation and transportation tariff and rider.
  - (c) Establishment of a deferral mechanism to track storm costs.
  - (d) Amortization of the balance of the regulatory assets.
- In the Gas Rate Case, Duke seeks a rate increase that would generate approximately \$44,607,929 of additional revenue, or an increase of 18.09 percent over current revenue. Upon review, the staff of the Commission recommends a revenue decrease from current revenue of between \$10,725,809 and \$3,358,775, or a decrease from current revenue of between 2.80 and 0.88 percent. The major issues in the Gas Rate Case include:
- (a) Revenue requirements as impacted by rate base, operating income, and rate of return.
- (b) Establishment of various riders, including: accelerated service line replacement program; facilities relocation and transportation; natural gas vehicle; gas generation interruptible transportation; and economic development.
  - (c) Changing the charge for reconnection of service.
- (d) Amendments to the accelerated main replacement program and rider (AMRP) and implementation of a rider for replacements not covered under rider AMRP.
  - (e) Continuation of its grid modernization initiative and rider.
- (f) Continuation of deferral authority for, and recovery of manufactured gas plant cleanup costs.
