The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) ASHTA Chemicals Inc. (ASHTA), is a mercantile customer, as defined in Section 4928.01, Revised Code, and obtains electric service from The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI). CEI is an electric distribution utility as defined in Section 4928.01, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- (2) On May 7, 2012, ASHTA filed an application for a reasonable arrangement, in accordance with Section 4905.31, Revised Code, and Rule 4901:1-38-05, Ohio Administrative Code.
- (3) By attorney examiner entry issued January 22, 2013, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for a hearing to commence on March 6, 2013, with testimony to be filed by February 27, 2013.
- (4) On February 22, 2013, ASHTA and Staff filed a joint motion for a continuance of the procedural schedule in this case. In support of their motion, ASTHA and Staff explain that business and commercial matters of ASHTA and ongoing discussions with Staff necessitate a continuance so that the parties have additional time for preparation. ASHTA and Staff request that the date for the filing of testimony be rescheduled to April 17, 2013, with the hearing to commence on April 24, 2013. Further, ASHTA and Staff certify that no party to this case objects to the requested continuance of the procedural schedule.

(5) The attorney examiner finds that the request by ASHTA and Staff is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the parties should observe the following procedural schedule:

- (a) All testimony should be filed by April 17, 2013.

ORDERED, That the motion to continue the procedural schedule filed by ASHTA and Staff be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the parties adhere to the procedural schedule as set forth in finding (5). It is, further,
