The Commission finds:


- (1) On November 26, 2012, Jaime Kemmerer (Respondent) filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (2) A prehearing conference was conducted on January 31, 2013. While the parties did not settle matters at that time, discussions continued in subsequent weeks.
- (3) On February 15, 2013, Commission staff filed a letter noting that Respondent had paid the civil forfeiture and requesting dismissal of the case.
- (4) Rule 4901:2-7-22, O.A.C., provides that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all other proceedings regarding that violation.
- (5) In view of the payment of the forfeiture, this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That this case be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.






