ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On January 18, 2013, the complainant, Michael J. Hreha, filed a complaint against the respondent, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, which alleges, among other things, that in responding to a flickering/dimming lights situation at his home, the respondent did not do its part in servicing the issue at hand.
- (2) On February 7, 2013, the respondent timely filed its answer, in which it admitted to certain of the allegations in the complaint but denied others.
- (3) On March 7, 2013, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss. The motion indicates that the parties have resolved all issues raised in the complaint. In addition, the parties request that the matter be dismissed with prejudice as a settled case.
- (4) The Commission finds that the parties' motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice is reasonable and should be hereby granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties' joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice be granted. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


