The Ordinance, by its terms, purports to shift the long-held legal principal that the City's streetcar operation should bear the costs of utility relocation, and instead functions to transfer the costs of the relocation away from the City and onto Duke Energy Ohio, and by extension, its customers.

14. Although Duke Energy Ohio does not question the authority of the City to regulate its streets, including the location of utilities, pursuant to a lawful exercise of its valid police power, the Ordinance, as it applies to the allocation of utility relocation costs, is not within the City of Cincinnati's home rule powers and represents a significant over reaching of the City's powers.

15. Ohio law has long held that the operation of a municipally owned streetcar is merely a proprietary, not a governmental, function of a City. As such, the City of Cincinnati cannot give its own streetcar preferential treatment or status under the law. Accordingly, the City cannot force other utilities operating in the street to relocate at their own cost to make way for the streetcar. The City is responsible for bearing the costs of relocation necessitated by its actions. Not only is this the law, it further comports with all concepts of equity and fairness.

16. If Duke Energy Ohio is required initially to pay for the costs of the relocation of the facilities used to serve its customers, which relocation is directly and proximately caused by the streetcar project, it is authorized pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4939 to seek recovery of all such costs. As a consequence, the relocation costs resulting from the City's streetcar project will, by law, be borne by Duke Energy Ohio customers, potentially including those customers located outside of the City of Cincinnati. If the City is successful in changing this established law, the net effect could be that customers across Duke Energy Ohio's system would be responsible for a very substantial part of the costs of the streetcar project.
