ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On October 1, 2012, The Frank Gates Service Company (complainant) filed a complaint against The Ohio Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Ohio (AT&T) relative to a billing dispute and allegations of deceptive and misleading practices by AT&T.
- (2) On December 4, 2012, AT&T filed its answer in this matter.
- (3) On March 15, 2013, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss. The motion indicates that the parties have resolved all issues raised in the complaint. In addition, the parties request that the matter be dismissed with prejudice as a settled case.
- (4) The Commission finds that the parties' motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties' joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice be granted. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


