ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On September 20, 2011, the Commission issued an entry on rehearing in *In the Matter of the Annual Alternative Energy Status Report of Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company*, Case No. 11-2479-EL-ACP. In that entry on rehearing, the Commission stated that it had opened the above-captioned case for the purpose of reviewing the Rider AER of Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (collectively, FirstEnergy or the Companies). Additionally, the Commission stated that its review would include the Companies' procurement of renewable energy credits for purposes of compliance with Section 4928.64, Revised Code.
- (2) The case proceeded to hearing on February 19, 2013, and continued through February 25, 2013. At the hearing, the attorney examiner established a deadline for the filing of initial briefs of April 8, 2013, and a deadline for the filing of reply briefs of April 29, 2013.
- (3) On March 29, 2013, the Environmental Law and Policy Center (ELPC) filed a motion to extend the deadline for the filing of initial briefs to April 15, 2013, and the deadline for the filing of reply briefs until May 6, 2013. In its memorandum in support, ELPC asserts that there is good cause for the one-week extension because ELPC and other parties are participating in multiple ongoing cases at the Commission; because more time is necessary to review the extensive record, including confidential portions of transcripts and exhibits; and, because ELPC anticipates it will be necessary to file both a confidential

and a public version of its brief. Finally, ELPC represents that it has discussed its motion with FirstEnergy, the Commission's Staff, Ohio Consumers' Counsel, Ohio Environmental Council, the Sierra Club, Mid-Atlantic Renewable Energy Coalition, Ohio Energy Group, Nucor Steel Marion, Inc., and Interstate Gas Supply, Inc., and that none of these parties objected to the proposed one-week extension.

- (4) The attorney examiner finds that ELPC's motion for a one-week extension of the deadlines for filing briefs is reasonable and should be granted. Therefore, parties shall file initial briefs by April 15, 2013, and reply briefs by May 6, 2013.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That parties shall file initial briefs by April 15, 2013, and reply briefs by May 6, 2013. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
