ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On March 30, 2012, DP&L filed an application for a standard service offer (SSO) pursuant to Section 4928.141, Revised Code. The application was for a market rate offer in accordance with Section 4928.142, Revised Code. On September 7, 2012, DP&L withdrew its application for a market rate offer. On October 5, 2012, DP&L filed an application for an electric security plan in accordance with Section 4928.143, Revised Code. Additionally, DP&L filed accompanying applications for approval of revised tariffs, for approval of certain accounting authority, for waiver of certain

Commission rules, and to establish tariff riders. On December 12, 2012, DP&L amended its application for an electric security plan.

- (3) The case proceeded to hearing on March 18, 2013, and continued through April 3, 2013. During the hearing, parties requested that they be granted 30 days to file post-hearing briefs and 15 days to file reply briefs.
- (4) The attorney examiner finds that post-hearing briefs should be filed by May 20, 2013, and reply briefs by June 5, 2013. Any party or individual desiring to access or copy the confidential portions of the transcript or confidential exhibits should abide by the attorney examiner entry that was filed on April 10, 2013.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That post-hearing briefs be filed by May 20, 2013, and reply briefs by June 5, 2013. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
