

On January 14, 2013, a vehicle operated by O & P OIL AND GAS INC, and driven by JAMES R DEAN, was inspected within the State of Ohio. As the result of discovery of the following apparent violation the Staff timely notified Respondent pursuant to Rule 4901:2-7-07, O.A.C., that it intended to make a civil monetary assessment against Respondent in the following amount:
