ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 1, 2013, Big R Trucking, LLC requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (2) By entry issued March 7, 2013, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing conference for March 21, 2013. The parties participated in the conference but were unable to resolve matters.
- (3) Accordingly, a hearing shall be scheduled for May 21, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. in Hearing Room 11-D, at the Commission offices, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (4) Rule 4901:2-7-14(A), O.A.C., provides that a respondent who has requested an administrative hearing and fails to participate in the hearing proceeding shall be in default. The rule additionally states that a respondent in default shall be deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violation and waived all further right to contest liability to the state for the forfeiture described in the notice.
- (5) At the hearing, staff must prove, by a preponderance of the evidence, that respondent committed the alleged violation, pursuant to Rule 4901:2-7-20(A), O.A.C.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a hearing be scheduled as indicated in Finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
