The Applicant hereby modifies its intrastate access service tariff in accordance with the FCC's Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, WC Docket Nos. 10-90, et al., FCC No. 11-161 (released November 18, 2011), as well the Commission's Entry in Case No. 10-2387-TP-COI.

With this filing, the Applicant modifies its applicable terminating access rates to equal those charged for interstate services. Per the FCC's March 26th Order, DA 13-553, which delayed the effective day of interstate tariffs in order to allow statutory notice, the effective date for its state access tariff to mirror its interstate access rates will be July 2, 2013.
