- 1. TNCI-OpCo is applying for approval to acquire the customers and certain assets, including the Certificates of Public convenience and Necessity of Trans National Communications International, Inc. As part of that Application, TNCI-OpCo provides its financial statements as Exhibit C-4 (the "Confidential Exhibit").
- 2. TNCI-OpCo is a privately held company and is not required to file financial information with the United States Securities and Exchange Commission and does not otherwise disclose its financial information to the public.
- 3. TNCI-OpCo uses its best efforts to keep and maintain the confidentiality of the Confidential Exhibit. To the best of the Company's knowledge, the Confidential Exhibit has not been disclosed or released to the public.
- 4. The Confidential Exhibit derives economic value from not being generally known to and not being readily ascertainable by proper means by other person who can obtain economic value from their disclosure and use. Specifically, the information contained therein is extremely sensitive financial information that could be used by competitors to determine revenue and other

information damaging to the Company. Disclosure of such information would be extremely

detrimental and could be used by the Company's competitors to materially affect the Company's

ability to compete effectively.

Due to the sensitive nature of the Confidential Exhibit, it is appropriate for the

Commission to limit access to it. The Confidential Exhibit should solely be used by the

Commission in exercising its governmental functions in considering TNCI-OpCo's Application.

There is no legitimate purpose or public interest to be served in disclosing the Confidential

Exhibit to the Company's current or future competitors or to any person other than the

appropriate staff of the Commission.

WHEREFORE, TNCI Operating Company LLC respectfully requests that the

Commission grant a Protective Order allowing Exhibit C-4 of the Application to be treated as

confidential.
