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EXAMINER SEE: Scheduled for hearing today at this time is Case No. 13-217-GA-GCR, entitled In the Matter of the Regulation of the Purchased Gas Adjustment Clauses Contained Within the Rate Schedules of the Waterville Gas & Oil Company and Related Matters, and also Case No. 13-317-GA-UEX, entitled In the Matter of the Uncollectible Expense Rider of the Waterville Gas & Oil Company and Related Matters.

My name is Greta See. I am the attorney examiner assigned to this case by the Commission. At this time I'd like to take appearance of the parties.

MR. MARGARD: Thank your Honor. On behalf of the staff of the Public Utilities

Your Honor, I am also authorized this morning to enter the appearance of Mr. Robert S.

Black, president of the Waterville Gas Company, 700

Farnsworth Road, Waterville, Ohio. Because all of the issues in this case have been completely resolved, Mr. Black will not be actually in attendance this morning.

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EXAMINER SEE: Thank you.

Mr. Margard, since you indicated that all the matters in the case have been resolved, is there a stipulation?

MR. MARGARD: There is, your Honor. If I may, I'd like to mark a number of exhibits before I offer my first witness. I would request be marked as Staff Exhibit No. 1 the report of the staff of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio in Case
No. 13-217-GA-GCR, Financial Audit of the Gas Cost Recovery Mechanisms for the Effective GCR Periods February 1, 2011, through January 31, 2013.

I'd like to mark as Staff Exhibit No. 2 a report of the staff of the Public Utilities

Commission of Ohio in Case No. 13-317-GA-UEX, the Audit of the Uncollectible Expense Mechanisms for the Period January 2011 through December 2012.

I'd also like to ask to be marked as
Waterville Exhibit No. 1 the proof of publication for
the hearing in this matter, and as Joint Exhibit
No. 1 the stipulation and recommendation filed in

MARGARD: Your Honor, in support of 6 these documents I'd like to call Mr. Roger Sarver to 7 testify, please. EXAMINER SEE: Okay. Mr. Sarver, please 8 step forward. Please raise your right hand. 9 10 (Witness sworn.) EXAMINER SEE: Thank you. Have a seat. 11 12 13 ROGER L. SARVER being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was 14 examined and testified as follows: 15 16 DIRECT EXAMINATION 17 By Mr. Margard: 18 State your name and your business Q. 19 address, please. 20 A. My name is Roger L. Sarver. My business 2.1 address is 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 22 43215. And by whom are you employed and in what 23 Q.

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capacity, please?

A. I'm employed by the Public Utility

- Commission of Ohio as an engineer specialist.
- Q. And in that capacity did you have any responsibility for the cases currently before the Bench today?
 - A. Yes. I supervised both of these audits.
 - Q. Do you have before you what's been marked as Staff Exhibits 1 and 2?
 - A. Yes, sir.

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- Q. Were these the documents that were prepared by you or at your direction as a part of that audit process?
 - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. And do you have any changes to make or corrections to make to either of these documents today?
 - A. No, sir.
- Q. Mr. Sarver, do you also have before you what's been marked as Joint Exhibit No. 1, the stipulation and recommendation in this case?
 - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Were you involved in discussions that resulted in this stipulation and recommendation?
- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. In your opinion, does this reflect the bargaining of knowledgeable and capable parties?

- A. Yes, sir. This was a stipulation put together largely by myself and Mr. Black to resolve all the issues found by staff in the performance of its GCR and UEX audits.
- Q. And does this agreement serve the public interest?
 - A. Yes, sir, it does.

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- Q. And can you give us some examples of why you believe that to be the case.
- A. The purpose of the stipulation is to resolve the issues that were found during the course of the audit. The point of both of these audits were to ensure the customers were not being overbilled for costs incurred by Waterville Gas & Oil Company through its gas cost recovery mechanism and UEX.

Staff verified the costs that were reflected in Waterville's gas cost recovery mechanisms and UEX riders were representative of the costs that they incurred and the audit found that no errors were being -- no errors were made.

- Q. The audits do make some recommendations; is that correct?
- A. Correct. The staff is looking for Waterville to continue to refine its calculation of its expected gas cost. Staff believes that that

mechanism is being overstated at this time and the company should continue to work to refine that calculation to better match its revenue collection with its costs incurred.

- Q. Am I correct in understanding the Joint Exhibit No. 1 reflects that the company has accepted all of the recommendations advanced by staff in Staff Exhibits 1 and 2?
 - A. Yes, sir.

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- Q. Do you believe that Joint Exhibit No. 1 violates any regulatory rule or principle?
 - A. No, sir.
- Q. And do you believe it to be fair and reasonable in its terms?
 - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. And is it your recommendation that it be adopted by the Commission in these matters?
 - A. Yes, sir.

MR. MARGARD: Your Honor, I have no further questions for Mr. Sarver.

Q. Mr. Sarver, you've worked for the Public

Utilities Commission for a number of years; how many?

A. Twenty-five.

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- Q. Okay. And is this your first time working with Mr. Black with Waterville?
- A. I think the first time I worked with Mr. Black was in 1990.
- Q. So you've worked with Mr. Black on similar cases for --
 - A. Twenty-three years.
- Q. Okay. So he is knowledgeable and understands the GCR audit and uncollectible expense audit process?
- A. Yes. He's actually been in this business longer than I have been. Since the 1970s.

15 EXAMINER SEE: Okay. Thank you.

(Witness excused.)

17 EXAMINER SEE: Mr. Margard.

MR. MARGARD: Your Honor, I have no further questions, and I also have no further witnesses, and I would respectfully move for the admission of Staff Exhibits 1 and 2, Waterville Exhibit 1, and Joint Exhibit 1.
