Code 4901:1-6-14(F)(5) on May 23, 2013. The notice was also forwarded to the Office of the Ohio Consumer's Counsel on May 23, 2013. The executed affidavit will be filed in this docket after the customer notice is provided on the customer's June 1, 2013 invoices. Middle Point Home Telephone Company is filing two separate tariff applications but will have one bill message to cover both for the customer so it is less confusing. We will file both a BLS and ATA tariff application at approximately the same time and both will be effective on July 1, 2013.

Effective on July 1, 2013, TSC/Middle Point will implement a revised rate schedule for basic local exchange service for customers throughout its exchange areas. The affective services and revised rates will be as follows:
