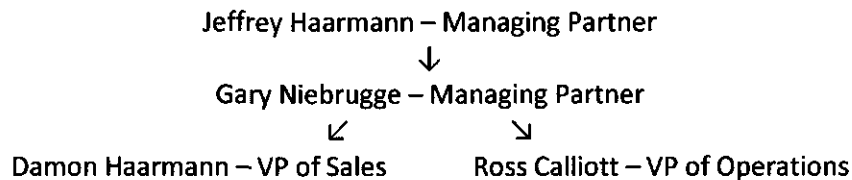


Exhibit A -13 Company History

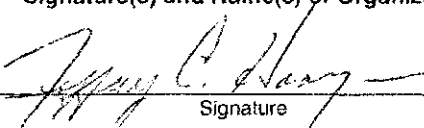

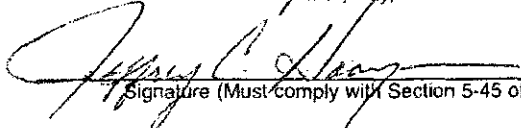
