- (1) Commission Staff has served a notice of preliminary determination upon Extreme Logistics, LLC, (Extreme Logistics) in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On May 17, 2013, Extreme Logistics filed a request for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned case in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) As set forth in Rule 4901:2-7-16(B), O.A.C., unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed to by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be scheduled following the filing of a request for administrative hearing.
