# SERVICE CHARGE <br> Business Residence 

### 1.02.05. NON PAYMENT RECONNECTION

When service to a customer is suspended or terminated for non-payment of bills, and the customer requests reconnection of his service at the same location, he will be charged:
A. Service Ordering Charge, Subsequent, per occasion $\qquad$ See Paragraph 1.02.01.
B. Central Office Charge, per line. $\qquad$ See Paragraph 1.02.03.
C. Premises Visit, when required per occasion $\qquad$ See Paragraph 1.02.02.

These charges are in addition to all past charges not paid and any other charges for installation, relocation, and change requested by the customer.

### 1.03. LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

A late payment charge of 1.50 percent on the unpaid balance or $\$ 7.50$, whichever is greater, applies to each residential customer's bill when the previous month's bill has not been paid in full, leaving a balance of $\$ 30.00$ or more. A late payment charge of 1.50 percent on the unpaid balance or $\$ 10.00$, whichever is greater, applies to each business customer's bill when the previous month's bill has not been paid in full, leaving a balance of $\$ 10.00$ or more. The late payment charge will be assessed on the past due amount thirty (30) days after the bill date. Late payment charges will not apply to service order charges associated with commencement of Lifeline service. The late payment charge will not apply to any Interexchange Carrier billing to which a late payment fee has already been rendered by an Interexchange Carrier. Each residential customer shall be permitted a one-time waiver of a monthly late payment charge in cases where the customer has already paid the monthly bill for which the late payment charge was applied, and upon request of the customer.

This charge does not apply to:

- amounts which are in dispute at the time the late payment charge would otherwise be applied.
- amounts previously billed as a late payment charge.
