Staff would like to voluntarily dismiss one of the inspection numbers, that being the inspection identified as OH3269008982, and with respect to the other inspection number, that being OH3269009388C, we would move for a default under Commission Rule 4901:2-7-14(E), "A Respondent who has requested an administrative hearing and fails to appear for the hearing shall be in default," and to support that motion, we'd like to offer two pieces of evidence into the record. The first I'd like to have marked as Staff Exhibit 1.

ATTORNEY EXAMINER SHEETS: Yes.

MR. O'ROURKE: Staff Exhibit 1 is the Notice of Preliminary Determination that was sent to the Respondent with respect to the inspection number with the last three characters 88C.

I'd also like to admit Staff Exhibit 2 along with our motion as well.

May I approach?

ATTORNEY EXAMINER SHEETS: Yes.

MR. O'ROURKE: Now, if we look at Staff Exhibit 1, it lists the violations that were cited against the Respondent. The first one was a violation of 392.9, and that was for the driver -- or that provision says, "Driver may not operate a commercial motor vehicle without proper load securement." Here, if we look on the inspection report, the Respondent was cited because there were unsecure roofing shingles on the left side front of the truck.

The second violation was a violation of 390.21A, the vehicle was not marked in accordance with the regulations. There was no company name displayed, and the final violation was for OAC 2-1-04, and that was a failure of the Respondent to present a PUCO tax receipt.

That concludes our presentation, your Honor. We would request for admission of our exhibits into evidence.
