ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On May 16, 2013, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) issued an Order in WC Docket No. 10-90, *In the Matter of the Connect America Fund* (May 16th Order), regarding filing certain information pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §54.313. As part of its Order, the FCC reminded all eligible telecommunications carriers (ETCs) that, to the extent applicable, they are required to file an annual report by July 1, 2013.
- (2) Pursuant to the attorney examiner Entry of May 31, 2013, all ETCs were notified that, in addition to complying with the May 16th Order by filing the requisite information with the FCC, all responding ETCs should file a copy of their FCC responses in this docket.
- (3) On June 10, 2013, the FCC issued an Order in WC Docket No. 10-90 granting a brief limited waiver of the established filing deadline for all information required under 47 C.F.R. §54.313, with the exception of 47 C.F.R. §54.313(h) which is still required to be filed with the FCC on July 1, 2013. Regarding the new filing deadline, the FCC stated that it will subsequently issue a Public Notice announcing the new deadline for ETCs to submit their required information.
- (4) Consistent with the FCC's June 10, 2013, Order, the responding ETCs should continue to file a copy of their July 1, 2013, 47 C.F.R. §54.313(h) responses in this docket. All other 47 C.F.R. §54.313 responses should be filed in this docket consistent with the FCC's future established time frame.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That all ETCs comply with Finding (4). It is, further,

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ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served via the Commission's electronic mail Telephone Industry Service List, upon all incumbent local exchange carriers, all competitive local exchange carriers, all providers of telephone toll service, all wireless service providers registered with the Commission, and all parties of record.
